Event Details:

1. Students audition by MP3 for this event. See details for audition below.
2. Selected participants are announced by May 2018.
3. Selected participants must pay a \$36 participation fee by the last day of school.
4. RPEMS will provide the selected music and then students must participate in local rehearsals to prepare for the event. The first rehearsal will be the first day of summer, then one rehearsal in July. Selected students are required to work on their own with their rehearsal tracks every day as soon as they receive their music.
5. Selected participants will be required to provide their own chaperone to escort them to the site. The final concert is the same day, in the evening.

Students are responsible for all transportation costs.

6th Grade = Jubilate Deo in two neighboring voice parts. See RPEMS Choir Website for practice tracks.

7th and 8th Grade =

1. VOCALIZATION : Sing the top 5 (ascending) pitches and bottom 5 (descending) pitches of your range on "loo" or "ah" unaccompanied.
2. My Country 'Tis of Thee/America: Starting on the pitches listed below, sing the first verse unaccompanied.
*For My Country 'tis of Thee begin on the following pitch for each voice part. (above or below middle C)
Soprano: A above Alto: E above Tenor: A below Baritone: F below
3. SOLO: One to two minutes of an Aria, Art Song, or Folk Song, etc. (with or without accompaniment)

Mrs. Twenter will provide an acceptable solo and rehearsal tracks.

****MP3's will be sent either via email or by CD - depending on the student's preference.****
