National Anthem Performances

The RPEMS Vocal Music Department is proud to partner with the Kansas City Mavericks Hockey Team in order to provide three opportunities for our students to perform the National Anthem for our community. These performances are not mandatory or for a grade, but do require a fee in order to participate.

6th Grade - Hero's Harmony - School Day at the Mavs November 13th

This game is during the school day. Students who are interested in going will need to purchase a \$15 ticket (which covers their ticket and bus fee) and a \$12 Choir t-shirt. All students will need a completed district permission form returned in order to attend. Choir t-shirts are available for purchase at any time in the Choir room, students only need to bring payment and will be sent home with a shirt. Parents may designate a size or Mrs. Twenter will choose what size looks to fit the student the best. Students who have failing grades or missing work will not be allowed to attend. Parent chaperones will be required. If you are interested in serving as a parent chaperone, contact Mrs. Twenter and your name will be put on the list. We will choose one parent per 10 students that go. The only way to guarantee that you can sit with your student is if you sign up to be a chaperone. Chaperones will need to purchase their ticket, but a t-shirt will be provided. Ticket orders are due September 28th in order to make necessary bus and chaperone arrangements. This will be a sell out game so we need to have all ticket orders in by the due date or we may not be able to get any extras. Chaperones will need to have a background check completed through the district. Students will not be able to be signed out at the game to ride home with their parents since it is a school day. Students may bring a lunch, purchase concessions, or purchase a pre-packaged lunch from the Mavericks for \$5 which includes a drink, sandwich and chips.

7th and 8th Grade Combined Performing Choir - Fall Game December 7th, 2018

This is an evening game. Students will return home after school, and then report back to load the busses between 5:00 PM and 5:30 PM depending on game start time. Students who are interested in going will need to purchase a \$15 ticket (which covers their ticket and bus fee) and a \$12 Choir t-shirt. All students will need a completed district permission form returned in order to attend. Choir t-shirts are available for purchase at any time in the Choir room, students only need to bring payment and will be sent home with a shirt. Parents may designate a size or Mrs. Twenter will choose what size looks to fit the student the best.

Parent chaperones will be required. If you are interested in serving as a parent chaperone, contact Mrs. Twenter and your name will be put on the list. We will choose one parent per 10 students that go. Chaperones will need to purchase their ticket, but a t-shirt will be provided. Student tickets are due November 15th in order to make necessary bus and chaperone arrangements. Chaperones will need to have a background check completed through the district. Parent tickets are due no later than November 30th if you want tickets in hand. We may still be able to purchase tickets after that, but they will be left at will call if purchased after November 30th. Families may chose to turn in all of their ticket orders by November 15th if they wish to. Students may stay with the group, or be signed out by a parent after we finish singing. Families can designate whether they want their student to sit with them or with the group. Students riding the bus back should have rides waiting in the parking lot by 10 PM.

7th and 8th Grade Combined Performing Choir - Spring Game February 8th, 2019

Same details as the Fall game with the following changes:

Student ticket orders are due January 15th. Family ticket orders are due February 1st. (May combine Family with Student tickets and turn all of them in on January 15th if you'd like to.)

In the event of inclement weather, and the district prohibits the busses from traveling, we will not receive refunds for our tickets, but will be offered an alternate game to use our tickets. We would not sing the National Anthem at that game, but families would have the option to attend with no additional cost. We would not take a bus to the second game however.
